India has a road network of over 5,472,144 kilometres, the second largest road network in the world. At (a) 66 km of roads per square kilometre of land, the quantitative density of India's road network is higher than that of Japan (0.91) and the United States (0.67), and far higher than that of China (0.46), Brazil (0.18) or Russia (0.08). However, qualitatively Indi<mark>a's r</mark>oads are a mix of imodern highways and narrow, unpaved roads. The rural roads in India form a substantial portion of the Indian road network. These roads are in poor shape, affecting the rural population's quality of life and Indian farmers' ability to transfer produce to market post-harvest. Over 30 percent of Indian farmers' harvests spoil postharvest because of the poor infrastructure. Many rural roads are of poor quality, potholed, and unable to withstand the loads of heavy farm equipment. These roads are also far from the all-season, good quality 2lane or highways, making economic resource flow slow, and logistical costs between different parts of India one of the highest in the world. For the development of these rural roads, Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana(or "Prime Minister Rural Roads Scheme"), was a launched December 2000 by the Indian government to provide connectivity to unconnected rural habitations. The scheme envisions that these roads will be constructed and maintained by the village panchayats. In some parts of India, where the government has attempted to manage it directly as a local social spending program, this program has produced limited results and no lasting change over 15 years, in either the quality or quantity of rural road network. The National Highways are the backbone of the road infrastructure and the major roads in India. They carry most of India's freight and passenger traffic. State highways and major district roads constitute the secondary and interconnecting ' roads in Expressways make up approximately 1,208 kilometre of India's road network. These high-speed roads are four-lane or six-lane, predominantly access controlled.
