No. G.S.R. 6/Const./Art. 309/2026.— In exercise of the powers conferred under the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Health Department Pharmacists (Group C) Service Rules, 1998, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Haryana Health Department Pharmacists (Group C) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2026.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Haryana Health Department Pharmacists (Group C) Service Rules, 1998 (hereinafter called as the said rules), in rule 9, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) Recruitment to the service shall be made,-

(a) in case of Pharmacy Officer,-

(i) 95% by direct recruitment, and

(ii) 5% by promotion from amongst Multi Purpose Health workers or Laboratory Technicians; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of any official already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.”

3. In the said rules, for Appendices A and B, the following Appendices shall be substituted, namely:-
