Subject:- Regarding filling up by direct recruitment 877 vacant paramedical posts of various cadres in the Kalyana Karnataka cadre of the Health and Family Welfare Department.

Reference:-Your office letter No.: NRC/98/2021-22, dated: 01/09/2023, 28/12/2023 and 23/08/2024.

With reference to the subject cited above, as requested in the letters referred to above, the proposal to fill, through direct recruitment, 877 vacant paramedical posts of various cadres in the Kalyana Karnataka cadre of the Health and Family Welfare Department was referred to the Finance Department and the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms for consultation.

Accordingly, since the Finance Department had not accorded concurrence for filling the 877 vacant paramedical posts of various cadres in the Kalyana Karnataka cadre of the Health and Family Welfare Department through direct recruitment, the opinion of the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms was sought as to whether, under Rule 10(2) of Notification No.: DPAR 6 PLX 2012, dated: 06.11.2013, concurrence of the Finance Department may be deemed to have been given and action may be taken to fill the said posts by direct recruitment in accordance with the Cadre and Recruitment Rules.

In this connection, the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Service Rules), in Note No.: DPAR 38 HP 2025, dated: 18/10/2025, has stated that, since the Finance Department has not accorded concurrence for filling the 877 vacant paramedical posts of various cadres in the Kalyana Karnataka cadre of the Health and Family Welfare Department by direct recruitment, concurrence of the Finance Department may be deemed to have been given under Rule 10(2) of Notification No.: DPAR 06 PLX 2012, dated: 06.11.2013, and has instructed, with the approval of the Chief Secretary, to undertake direct recruitment in accordance with the Cadre and Recruitment Rules.

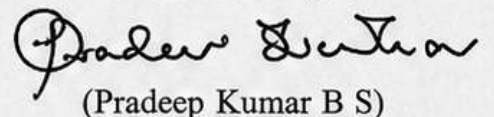
Therefore, in terms of Finance Department U.O. Note No.: FD 02 BODI 2021, dated: 24.11.2021, read with Circular No. 4 relating to cases of recruitment requiring concurrence, it has been clarified that where suitable budget provision is available under the appropriate head, appointment orders may be issued without awaiting separate concurrence from the Finance Department. In view of the same, the proposal for according suitable concurrence to fill, by direct recruitment, 877 vacant paramedical posts of various cadres in the Kalyana Karnataka cadre of the Health and Family Welfare Department was referred to the Finance Department on 14/11/2025 (copy enclosed).

In the above circumstances, in the Health and Family Welfare Department, Kalyana Karnataka cadre, the following 877 vacant paramedical posts of various cadres shown below are to be filled by direct recruitment, by following the applicable reservation rules and the conditions prescribed in Government Order No.: HFW 233 HFM 2023, dated: 21/12/2024, particularly clauses (2), (5) and (6).

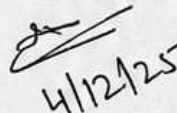
